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One of the unexpected outcomes of COVID-19 was exposure of the fragility of the supply chain. Many restaurants and bars now struggle to get needed alcohol delivery services. They are being dropped or having delivery schedules drastically reduced, as well as having significantly increased minimum order requirements.

### Industry Ask:

- Allow restaurants and bars to purchase limited quantities of beer for service/sale at a retailer. This is of particular importance to rural operators, who can fill a gap with a purchase, when they are between delivery times.
- Allow restaurants and bars to receive spirit deliveries directly from the state if minimum order quantities are met.

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
